# SILVER DOLLAR CITY/STONE MOUNTAIN PARK REPORT

Mr. Dombrowski said that Yellow Daisy went very well and was very well attended. HFEC had about 1000 more cars buying daily passes and 2000 more annual pass holders coming to Yellow Daisy than last year. HFEC tried to elevate the food experience at the festival and Mr. Dombrowski felt that they achieved their goal. Mr. Dombrowski said they were open to any suggestions on how to enhance the experience of Yellow Daisy.

The Pumpkin Festival is coming up in October. Tickets for Snow mountain will go on sale after October 1<sup>st</sup>. They will start making snow on October 5<sup>th</sup>. Snow Mountain will open to the public November 21<sup>st</sup>. Herschend is trying to improve the children's play area at Snow Mountain this year. They also want to reduce the wait times in line this year. Christmas starts the beginning of November.

## FINANCE REPORT – YEAR-TO-DATE

Ms. Zimmerman reported that the Finance Committee met earlier and discussed the financial statements through August 31, 2015. Total revenue year-to-date was \$7.5 million compared to a budget of \$7.0 million. Total operating expenses were about \$4.7 million compared to the budget of \$5.1 million. After depreciation the net income year-to-date is a loss of \$1.2 million compared to a budgeted loss of \$2.2 million.

## DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

Chief Kelley introduced John Bankhead to the Board. Mr. Bankhead was in the GBI for 20 years. He was the Public Information Officer and when he retired Chief Kelley was able to hire him part-time as SMMA's Public Information Officer. Mr. Bankhead is highly respected by all the media and works with the Department of Public Safety during all the special events.
