SIGHTS / RECREATION

- 1 GRIST MILL & COVERED BRIDGE** D-5
The area near the 100-year-old mill and bridge is a great place for picnics.
- 2 QUARRY EXHIBIT** D-6
This outdoor display brings to life the history of the granite industry at Stone Mountain.
- 3 WALK-UP TRAIL & CONFEDERATE HALL HISTORICAL & ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION CENTER** F-14
Visit the interactive exhibit gallery about the geology and ecology of the mountain, view the "Battle for Georgia" film and set out on the 1 mile trail to the top of the mountain.
- 4 HIKING/NATURE TRAILS** D-14
Experience the serenity of Stone Mountain Park on some of our scenic trails. These trails cover approximately 10 miles of beautiful land.
- 5 PLAYGROUND** C-12
The top-notch playground located near the Nature Trail is sure to provide hours of fun for the kids.
- 6 CARILLON** G-6
Enjoy daily concerts from our 732-bell Carillon, originally exhibited at the 1964 World's Fair.
- 7 SONGBIRD HABITAT AND TRAIL** A-10
Site of the 1996 Centennial Olympic Archery and Cycling venue, this area is now a songbird habitat, one mile meadow trail and one mile woods trail with a wide array of plant life and food for a variety of birds.
